Look to the skies. Jesus will return some day.

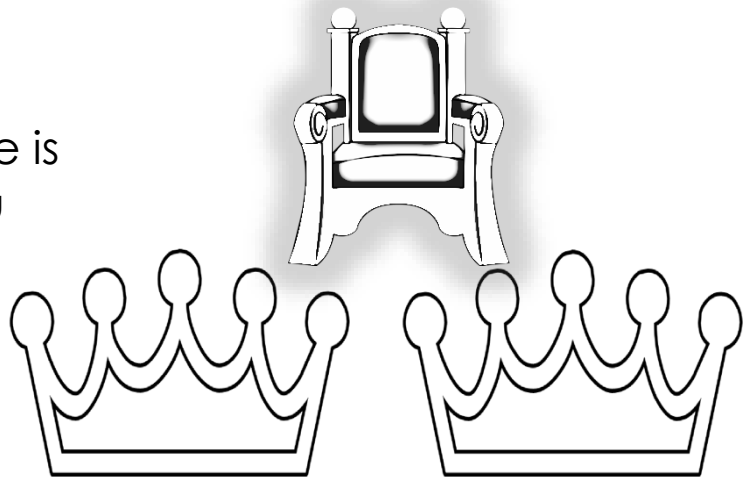

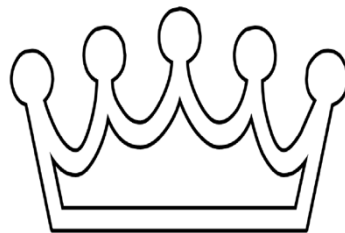
