The men touched his hands and feet. Then they believed that Jesus was the Messiah. Amazed and full of great joy, they worshipped him.

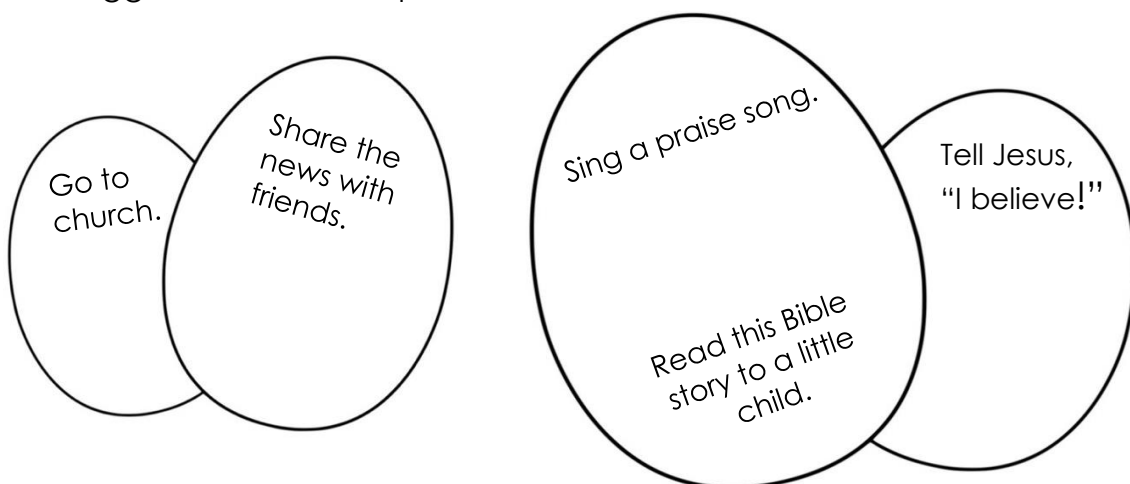
## Questions

## 41. Jesus Appears to His Disciples

Luke 24:13-41; 52-53 (edited) World English Bible (WEB)

Two of them were going that very day to a village.

While they talked and questioned together, Jesus himself came near, and went with them. But their eyes were kept from recognizing him. He said to them, "What are you talking about as you walk, and are sad?"

They said to him, "The things concerning Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people; and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him up to be condemned to death, and crucified him. Also, certain women of our company amazed us, having arrived early at the tomb; and when they didn't find his body, they came saying that they had also seen a vision of angels, who said that he was alive."

Beginning from Moses and from all the prophets, Jesus explained to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

Their eyes were opened and they recognized him; then he vanished out of their sight. They said to one another,

“Weren’t our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us along the way, and while he opened the Scriptures to us?”

They found the eleven gathered together, and those who were with them, saying, “The Lord is risen indeed.”

As they said these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, “Peace be to you.” But they were terrified and filled with fear, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.

He said to them, “Why are you troubled? Why do doubts arise in your hearts? See my hands and feet, that it is truly me. Touch me and see, for a spirit doesn’t have flesh and bones, as you see that I have.” When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. They worshipped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God.
