Bible Extension Activities: Trusting in Thick-as-Brick Times

In this activity, kids will build a wall out of boxes to understand the future.

Read to the children Genesis 4:1-16. **Ask:** How do you think Adam and Eve felt after their one son killed the other (Cain killed Abel)?

While you say the words below, let the children quietly **build a wall**. Use <u>blocks</u> or a collection of <u>cereal boxes</u> (they can be full):

Say: Not only did Adam and Eve lose their firstborn, but then Cain had to run away. Can you imagine the sadness about Abel and their worry about Cain? If you have ever gone through a loss or another huge sadness, the future can feel like a thick, brick wall. During those thick times, some people feel like they will never get past those bricks of bitterness or sadness. Sometimes people are afraid that they will hurt forever, that yesterday looks as hard as today. It's like they have a wall of fear because they cannot see the joy ahead.

Have the children **lay on the ground** and notice that they cannot see over the wall to what will happen tomorrow.

Say: God is in heaven. He sits above time, above fear, and above our worries. He sees over the wall of today to what joys lie ahead. What happiness was ahead for Adam and Eve?

Read Genesis 4:25-26. Say: Not only did they have another son, but that son (Seth) had a son and they became grandparents! They couldn't see that God had great blessings in store for them. Their tears of sadness were replaced with little boy giggles. And to make life even a little more fun, this baby looked just like his dad!

Have the children take turns **sitting on one side of the wall** and **say**ing what made them sad and then later glad (go to the other side of the wall). For example, one child might say, "When my parents got divorced, I was sad and mad. I thought my family was getting smaller. I didn't know what God already knew. Now (go to the other side of the wall), I have a step sister and a new step brother on the way!

Pray about the worries today and thank God for what he has planned for tomorrow.

Bible Extension Activities: Thick and Thin Song Motions

In this activity, use hand motions to sing the song.

Sing the song with the children to the tune of "Deep and Wide." See the short <u>video</u> at the link below to show you how to use hand motions and then leave out the words. The second time you sing the stanza, leave out saying the word "thin" but use the motion. The next time, leave out the word "thick" and use the motion as well.

Bible Extension Activities: God is with Us Scriptures

In this activity, kids will act out the verses and write them onto foot pads.

Read the verses below. As you read, the children can act them out. They can use some of the American Sign Language (ASL) motions cited in the song above. <u>Print this page</u> and let them work in teams. One team acts out a verse and the others guess which verse it is. (add "I" – point to your chest; "with" – thumbs up on each hand and bring hands together; "you" – finger pointing forward; God: <u>https://www.signasl.org/sign/god</u>

For extra fun, have the **kids trace and <u>cut</u> out their footprints** from <u>thin foam mats</u> (found in craft sections). Using <u>pen</u>, have them write one of the verses on the bottom of the pads and slip into their shoes to remember that God is always with them.


