Bible Extension Activities: Bible Basics and Child Protection

In this activity, kids will contrast and compare different Bible accounts.

Prepare: Photocopy <u>one copy for each child of the following page and our Bible story on page 2</u>. Have the children bring in <u>their own Bible</u>. Bring in children's illustrated Bibles.

Show the children how to look up the passage in Mark 10: 13-16. **Explain** how to find verses by the book, chapter, and verse. **Say:** God thinks children are so important and special, that he wanted to make sure that everyone knew how much Jesus loves the children. **Ask:** Can you find this story in these two other gospels? Help them understand what a gospel is – the Good News...the four stories of the life of Christ told in Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Explore the Bibles and the three similar passages. **Ask**: How many verses are in each story? What is the same and what is different? Circle anything that is unique. Compare/contrast our version of this Bible story (page 2 above). What did we add with our own imagination? What did Jesus mean when he said, "The Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are

like children?" What action did Jesus take with the children?

How did Jesus stand up for children?

How can you?



Important: Jesus very appropriately placed his hands on the children's heads for the important Jewish tradition of blessing a child (see more about blessings below). Please make sure your students understand this. It would be a good time to remind them that no one is allowed to touch a child anywhere else for any other reason. Review your church or school's safety manual. Remember, that if you teach children in any capacity, you are a mandated reporter of abuse. 14 But Jesus said, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are like these children." 15 And he placed his hands on their heads and blessed them before he left.

Jesus Blesses the Children Luke 18: 15-17

15 One day some parents brought their little children to Jesus so he could touch and bless them. But when the disciples saw this, they scolded the parents for bothering him. 16 Then Jesus called for the children and said to the disciples, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of God belongs to those who are like these children. 17 I tell you the truth, anyone who doesn't receive the Kingdom of God like a child will never enter it."

Bible Extension Activities: Shalom! Biblical Blessings

In this activity, kids will receive a blessing and parents will learn about it.

Prepare: Photocopy <u>one copy for each child of this page the following two pages.</u> Crayons or colored pencils. You will also need a way to play the <u>YouTube Blessing Song</u> on the following page.

Say: Why did Jesus bless the children? Jesus grew up in a Jewish home. The Jewish people are also called Jews, Hebrews, or Israelites. They have a beautiful tradition, which God taught them. It is blessing their children. A blessing is like a prayer. Read together Numbers 6:22-27. Let the **children color** the picture below while you explain about blessing. Let them listen to the **Blessing Song** and try to understand the words in bold.

For parents: Think about incorporating some of these wonderful traditions into your home. Not only will these practices impact your children today, but the blessings will last a lifetime! Here are some customs you can adapt to your own family: Every Friday night, light a candle. The dad will stand behind the son and the mother behind the daughter. The parents place one or both hands on the child's head and say or whisper the blessing. Ceremonial times bring new blessings. The sons say one line and the daughters another. Some Christian families add communion and other family members can bless each other.

- * a dedicated, Christian mate
- * peace in your spirit, soul, and body
- * health and happiness
- * concentration in your studies
- * great classmates and caring, kind teachers

- * blessings so you can be a blessing to many
- * understanding about who Jesus is and how to follow him



Bible Extension Activities: Do NOT Stop them!

In this activity, kids will play a bowling game.


Prepare: You will need a <u>soft ball</u>. Photocopy onto card stock <u>six of the following page</u>. Cut the outline and bend so that the image stands up.

Ask: What did the disciples say to Jesus? What did he say back? What stops you from going to church? **List the reasons** on the backs of the disciples' images. Here are six possible problems. **Brainstorm** ways to overcome each roadblock: 1. Staying up late the night before.

2. I need a ride to church. 3. Sometimes I just don't want to go. 4. Parents or relatives don't encourage me to go. 5. I'm afraid I won't fit in with the other kids there. 6. The service is long and I get bored.


Say: PREPARE! **Think of ways to overcome** each reason: go to bed on time, talk to my teachers about a ride; ask God to give you the desire to go. Invite your parents. Try to invite a child from your class to play. Go prepared with pages to color. You can use our pages from the story and song. Print them and bring a clipboard and crayons to church to quietly color during the service. Try to participate with the songs and sermon. Find out if there is a children's ministry and try it!

Set the "pins" (pictures of disciples) up in a triangle. As each child takes a turn **bowling**, have them first **repeat the verse**: "Let the children come to me. Do not stop them."



Use the reverse sides to think of ways to come into a closer relationship with Jesus: praying, listening to Christian songs, reading my Bible, getting baptized, having Christian friends, asking questions about what I don't understand, etc. **Play the game** the same way but use the picture of Jesus with the children.

Copy six of these pages onto card stock. Cut the outside and bend at the dotted line so the image stands up.
