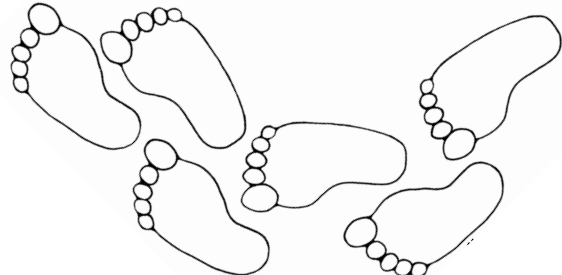
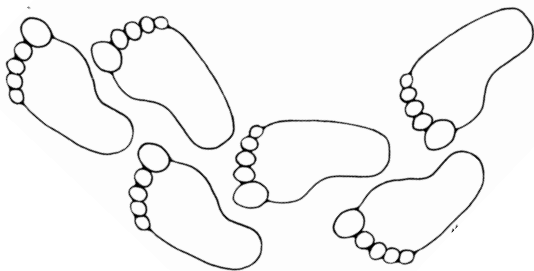
Questions

Luke 2:41-51 World English Bible (WEB)

His parents went every year to Jerusalem at the feast of the Passover.
