Bible Extension Activities: Why Did God Flood the Earth?

In this activity, kids will build and then destroy a tower of sand.

Prepare: Bring in two <u>buckets</u>, (one with sand) and a few <u>cups</u> to use as scoops. Bring in <u>a pitcher</u> to use with <u>water</u>.

Ask: Have you ever seen someone explode at someone else? What is the story behind the story? That anger has probably been growing for days or even years. Why did God become so angry with humans? **Read aloud** Genesis 6:1-13. If possible, use the New International Readers' version. https://www.biblegateway.com/passage/?search=genesis+6&version=NIRV

Ask: What did people do that filled God's heart with pain? **Say:** Let's build a tower out of sand. The tower will represent God's heart filling with pain.

Do: As the kids list the people's sins, they **scoop a cup of sand** one at a time into a hill of sand. **Say:** God's anger and sadness and disappointment had built up, up, up to the point that he was DONE! He was heart-broken! **Read** Genesis 6:7: "So the Lord said, "I created human beings, but I will wipe them out... I am very sad that I have made human beings."

Talk about sins we do today as individuals and as a society. Use the water to **wash away the tower** of sand. Each child will want to take a turn.

Extend the Fun: Use the <u>picture below</u> (full size on the next page). In the clouds, have your students write this poem or make one up of their own. Have them use a <u>pen</u> and then let the words dry. With <u>crayons</u>, they can color the clouds gray, white, different colors of blue. **Poem**: God was full of sadness. Why? Because the world was full of badness. I will obey like Noah did. Help me, Lord! I'm just a kid.


Note: Some might feel as though depicting God as below violates the second commandment. Read all of Exodus 20:4-6(KJV). verse 4: "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth." BUT... remember the reason behind the rule. The next verse explains more: "Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them." Certainly, we would not allow the children to bow down to their pictures. Children need concrete

images and ideas to learn well. Our invisible God can be hard for them to grasp. If you are not comfortable with the image below, then have the children just draw clouds and perhaps lightning.

Note: We also provide an alternative picture as an option to replace in the PPTs.

Bible Extension Activities: Two by Two, God Will Help You Too

In this activity, kids will match animal pictures to learn about God's help.

Prepare: Photocopy <u>two copies of both sets of animals</u> on the front and the verse blocks on the back of the pages. If you print onto cardstock, the game will be easier and last longer. Cut the cards


Ask: What did God ask Noah to do? How do you think he felt about that? Has God ever asked you to do a job that is hard or scary? **Say**: Maybe God wants you to sit with a child who is always alone at lunch. Maybe God is asking you to read your Bible every morning. **Ask**: What do you think he is asking YOU to do? Has God ever helped you obey him? How?

Say: The good news is that God will help you obey him. **Read** Genesis 6:17-22 and Genesis 7: 13-16. **Ask**: Did Noah have to tromp into the woods and trap a male and female bear? Did he or his sons have to climb through a jungle and lure two monkeys on board the ark? **Say**: What does verse 7:8-9 say? God <u>brought</u> the animals TO Noah, two by two. Two by two, God will help you too!

Look up 1 Chronicles 28. **Say**: Many years later, Solomon, the new king of Israel, was chosen to build a temple, a sanctuary for the Lord. Like building the ark, that was a huge task. His father David encouraged him with these words: "The Lord has chosen you. Be strong and do the work. God will enable you to understand all the details of the plan. Be strong and courageous and do the work. Do not be afraid of discouraged. God will not fail you."

Play a game of concentration. Lay out the sets of cards with the animals facing down. The children will turn cards over, two by two. If the set matches, they can keep it. Some rules say that if you match a set, you can go again. Who earned the most sets before the sets ran out? Each time you make a match, say the verses on the back of the cards: God chose you. He will help you. Be strong and do the work.


