


Luke 2:25-39 World English Bible (WEB)

Behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon.

This man was righteous and devout, looking for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was on him.

It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. He came in the Spirit into the temple.

When the parents brought in the child, Jesus, that they might do concerning him according to the custom of the law, then he received him into his arms, and blessed God, and said,

“Now you are releasing your servant, Master,
according to your word, in peace; for my eyes have
seen your salvation,
which you have prepared before the face of all
peoples; a light for revelation to the nations, and the
